It is vital that you sign and finalize your MA quickly (once received) to reserve your student's spot for Semester 2. If you know your student will not be returning next semester, please let me know.

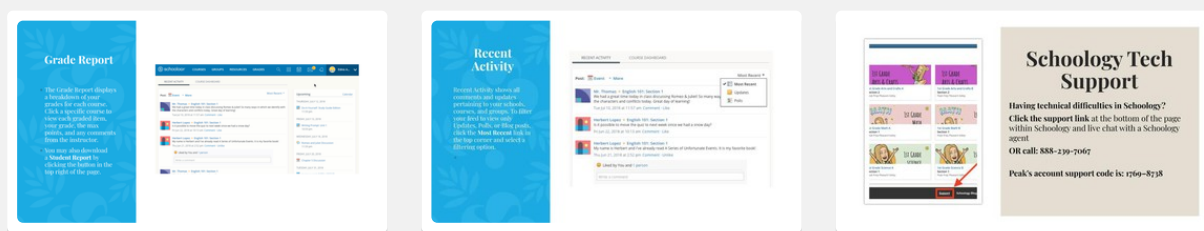

Tk-5

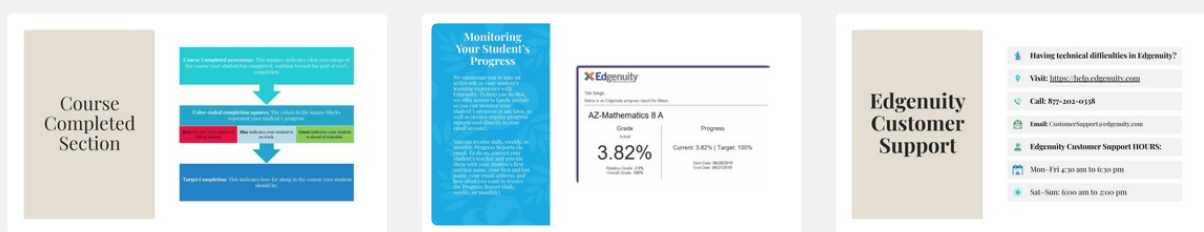
Pacing in grades TK-5 is based upon the schedule set by your teachers. If your student has missing assignments, please feel free to work during the upcoming break to catch-up, but do not forget to notify your teacher that you have uploaded a missing assignment.



6th-12th Grade

Pacing in Edgenuity is based upon the school calendar, which means that the system recognizes that students will not be expected to log in during Winter break. ***This is your student's opportunity to get back on track in their courses if needed.*** I would strongly encourage all students currently behind to use this time to catch up, but please be aware that our faculty will be unavailable during this break.

Please stress with your student(s) the importance of completing their assignments and maintaining a minimum 2.0 GPA with no Fs as a key to ensuring they do not fall behind their peers academically. Any student behind in their courses should be meeting with their teachers during Intervention hours to get extra help. As a reminder, you can also schedule 1-1 time with your teachers to get extra support when needed.

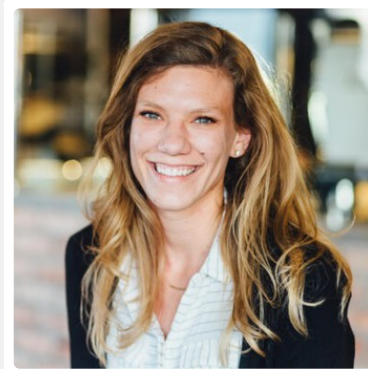

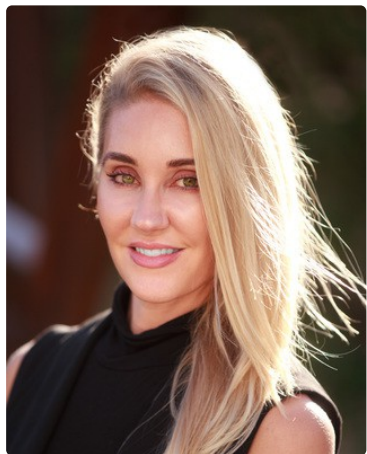
