Dear High School Families,

A new law passed, Assembly Bill 104, that allows 9th-12th grade families an opportunity to request a grade change for their 2020-2021 school year transcript. The changes will not impact their grade point average. There is no limit on the number of the grades earned during the 20-21 school year that can be changed to a Pass/No Pass.

In addition to grade changes, the law requires the Cal State system to accept a grade of Pass during the 20-21 school year. However, the University of California system has been ENCOURAGED (not required) to accept a Pass on student's transcripts for the 2020-2021 school year. Private colleges/universities are not required to accept a grade of Pass in place of a letter grade. The link to [the list](#) of schools that will accept them is provided below.

The request must be completed within 15 days of this notice. The attached Grade Change Request [application](#) for school year 2020–21 must be filled out and submitted to Sabrina.Ciolino@peak-prep.org pursuant to *Education Code* Section 29066.5 (2)(b). We will not make any changes if requests are made after 15 days from the date of this notice.

Please keep in mind that some post secondary institutions may not accept a pass on the transcript for the 2020-2021 school year so make sure to double check [the list](#) if you desire to go to a four year university after H.S. Graduation.
